




Letter from the Owner

Perhaps finding a sole pet sitter that pet sits and this is her full-time professional career and not a hobby. If not, they are most likely not fully committed to your time, and to caring for your pets.
- 3. Do not hire the kid next door. It's a great way for "Timmy" to earn extra cash, but remember they're also kids. Which means they are forgetful, lose interest quickly, and have no experience needed to handle an emergency should one arise. You can blame them; their brains are not fully developed yet. Your pets are a big part of your family and your heart, they are your heart and soul, so make sure you get someone who is experienced and mature to care for them while you're away. Would you go out of town and leave your baby with the teenager for a week?
